

MISSION TO UGANDA 2011

Arkwings Foundation and First Baptist Church are sponsoring a mission trip to Uganda in 2011. Team members are being sought for the March 12-23 mission to Restoration Gateway, a ministry to the primarily refugee population of northern Uganda suffering from the affects of war and displacement. Patterned after its successful 2009 mission, the team will provide medical care, dental care, eye care and health education to people who have spent the past 20 years living a nightmare. The team will also participate in spiritual activities, including children and youth education and recreation programs.

Although no special skills are required (everyone can contribute), the team is particularly interested in medical, dental and eye care practitioners with nurses and nurse practitioners especially sought. Horticulture experts and health educators along with other teachers and experienced mentors would also be useful.

The all-inclusive cost of participating in the mission is \$3,100. This covers airfare, ground transportation, lodging, and meals and includes a trip to one of Africa's finest game preserves, sight-seeing and shopping. A limited amount of financial aid will be available. A deposit of \$1700 is due by Dec. 1st. \$1600 can be refunded up to Jan. 12th.
